I hereby request and consent to a search being made by the automated criminal records retrieval system maintained by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to determine if I have been convicted of, and have been granted a pardon/record suspension for any of the sexual offences that are listed in the schedule of the Criminal Records Act. I understand that, as a result of giving this consent, if I am suspected of being the person named in a criminal record for one of the sexual offences listed in the schedule to the Criminal Records Act in respect of which a pardon was granted or issued, that record may be provided by the Commissioner of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to the Solicitor General of Canada, who may then disclose all or part of the information contained in that record to a police force or other authorized body. The police or authorized body will then disclose that information to me.
